1. Eligibility

Artwork themed for HELPING YOUR COMMUNITY in the environment, animals, or people. All students must be enrolled in any home, private, or public school in K-8th grade and no more than 14 years of age. Collaborative works of art are not eligible. Artwork found not to be original is automatically disqualified. Only one piece of art per artist is allowed to be submitted.

2. Judging

One Best of Show and two additional winners are selected in grades K-5 section and also in grades 6-8 section. All judging is done by Art Quotient's judging committee and winners are selected based on their creativity, interpreting the theme and artistic merit. Prizes will be awarded to the Best of Show winner of each grade section.

3. Entering Your Artwork

Submit in original, printed or digital format. Digital submissions must be TIFF format at 300 DPI with a hard copy attached at 5" x 7". In addition to sending in the form, attach a copy of the submission form to your art.

4. Important Notes

No submission fees are required. Submission is FREE. All submissions must be accompanied by signature from a parent, art instructor, other teacher or principal (space provided in form above). AQ is not liable for any copyright infringement on the part of the entrant.

By signing above, artwork submitted for publication does not become the property of AQ, but AQ reserves the right to use any submission for advertising and promotional purposes, commercial or noncommercial, for the promotion of AQ. Permissions to use artwork include but is not limited to public exhibition and/or reproduction of the artwork for print or online in digital/electronic, and/or multimedia formats in order to promote AQ K-8 Art Program. Request for return of your artwork entry must be accompanied by proper postage (SASE) and packaging. Requests without return postage will not be returned. Art Quotient is not responsible for lost or damaged works.

5. Winners

Up to 20 winners may be published in our full-color art annual. Published winners will be notified by email, letter or telephone and receive one copy of the Art Quotient Art Annual.
